Notice Inviting Tender

Sealed Item Rate tenders are invited for the following work by Executive Engineer, Western division No. 10 on behalf of DDA up to 3.00 p.m. on the dates mentioned below from the approved contractors and eligible contractors of DDA & CPWD and those of appropriate list of P & T, MES & Railways which shall be opened on the same day at 3.30 p.m. at Ground Floor, Vikas Minar, IP Estate, New Delhi in the presence of intending purchaser or their authorized representative.

The tender documents can be obtained on any working day from the CAU (Dwarka)/Sale Counter, Vikas Minar between 11.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. on payment of cost of tender (non-refundable) on production of valid enlistment certificate. Sale of tender will be stopped four days (including the date of opening) before the date fixed for the opening of tender documents.

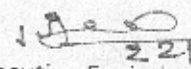
- 1) For works costing up to Rs 25.00 lakh incase of B&R tenders shall be issued to contractors registered with DDA only.
- 2) For works costing above Rs. 25.00 lakh up to Rs. 2.00 crore. Tenders shall be issued to DDA and CPWD enlisted contractors as per their enlistment. The tenders shall also be issued to non DDA, non CPWD contractors provided they have satisfactorily completed three similar nature of works, each of value not less than 40% of the estimated cost in the last five years after getting the documents verified from the E.E./WD-10. The contractor, whose contract is determined or rescind, shall not be allowed to participate in the tendering process for the balance work.

The manner of submission of tender, opening of the same and entry of contractor or their authorized representative to the place of opening shall be as provided in Clause 3 (a), (b) and (c) of PWD-6 forming part of the tender documents.

The tender shall be accompanied with earnest money in cash (up to Rs 10,000/- only) Receipt, Treasury Challan/Deposit at Call Receipt of a Scheduled Bank/Fixed Deposit Receipt of a Scheduled Bank/Demand Draft of a Scheduled Bank issued in favour of Sr A.O., CAU (Dwarka), DDA 50% of the Earnest Money or Rs. 20.00 (twenty) lac; whichever is less, shall be in the form prescribed above and balance can be accepted in the form of Bank Guarantee issued by a scheduled bank.

It shall be ensured that Demand Draft/Fixed Deposit Receipt is valid for a period of six months or more after the last date of receipt of tender and the same shall be in favour of Sr Accounts Officer, CAU (Dwarka). No interest shall be paid on Earnest Money as deposited with DDA.
