

The tender documents can be had on any working day from the Sr. AO/CAU/Rohini Zone/DDA or from Tender Sale's Counter at Vikas Minar, DDA Office, I.P. Estate, New Delhi between 11.00 am to 3.00 pm on payment of cost of tender (non refundable) as well as amount of earnest money in the prescribed manner as mentioned against each work on production of valid enlistment registration certificate, and valid registration with works contract cell of Sales Tax deptt. Of GNCTD and Tax clearance certificate issued by work cell in Form XL. Sale of tender forms will be stopped 4 (Four) days including date of opening before the date fixed for opening of tenders.


The manner of submission of tender, opening of same and entry of contractor's/their authorizes representative to the place of opening shall be provided in clause three 3(a), (b) and (c) of PWD-6 forming part of the tender documents.

1. Item rate/percentage tenders are invited for the work on behalf of DDA from the approved contractors of eligible contract of DDA & CPWD and those of appropriate list of P & T, MES and Railways, which shall be opened on the same day.
 The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of sale of tenders.
 In case only the last date of sale of tenders is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of sales of tender
 In case both the last date of receipt of application and the sale of tenders are extended the enlistment of contractor should be valid on either of the two date i.e. original date of sale of tender or on the extended date of sale of tenders.
- 1.2 For works costing upto Rs.25 lacs in case of B & R, tenders shall be issued to contractors registered with DDA Only.
- 1.3 For works costing above Rs. 25 Lacs upto Rs 2 crores, tenders shall be issued to DDA & CPWD enlisted contractors as per their enlistment. The tenders shall also be issued to Non-DDA, non-CPWD contractors provide they have satisfactorily completed three similar nature of works, each of value not less than 40% of the estimated cost in the last five years.
- 1.4 For works costing above Rs.2 crores but upto Rs.10 crores, the tenders shall be issued to DDA as well as non-dda contractors provide they have satisfactorily completed three similar nature of works, each of value not less than 40% of the estimated cost or two works of similar nature, each of value not less than 50% of the estimated cost or one work of similar nature of value not less than 80% value not less than 50% of the estimated cost in the last 7 years ending the last of the month previous to the one in which the tenders are invited.
 Note-Class 2 contractors of DDA & CPWD shall also be eligible if they satisfy the criteria specified in 1.4 above.
- 1.5 For works costing above Rs.10 crores, there shall be pre-qualification/post qualification as the case may be as per existing practice.







TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The work comprises of maintenance of street lighting as per the inventory attached.
2. Scope of work is as under:
 - i) To keep all street lighting points and all allied installations in working order
 - ii) To keep the street lighting functional during the timings fixed by the Engineer-in-Charge.
 - iii) Street lighting should be switched ON/OFF at appropriate time fixed by the department.
3. 90% of the street lighting should remain in working order & functional through out the period of contract failing which proportionate recovery shall be made from the contractor's bill.
4. No street lighting points should remain out of order for more than 3 days. Beyond 3 days, a recovery of Rs.50/- per point, per day, shall be made from the contractor's bill.
5. Proper handing/taking over all the E&M installations shall be carried out by JE(E)/AE(E) incharge of the work and the contractor in writing immediately award of work before start of work. The same shall be handed over to the department in proper working condition after expiry of the contract.
6. The contractor shall depute the following staff under the contract.

(a) Wireman grade – I	1 No. (from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. / as desired by Engineer in charge)
(b) Khallasi	1 No. (from 6 p.m. to 10p.m. / as desired by Engineer in charge)
7. The duty timings of the staff can be changed as and when required by the Engineer-in-Charge.
8. The contractor shall deploy trained and competent staff to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-Charge.
9. The contractor shall supply the list of staff along with details i.e. Name, Father's Name, Date of Birth, Experience Certificate to be engaged on the installation within 7 days of award of work. Engineer - in - Charge shall have the right to reject any staff deployed by the contractor.
10. The staff deployed by the contractor shall wear proper uniform and badges displaying their name and designation.
11. The contractor shall deploy staff throughout the period of contract i/c Saturdays, Sundays, Gazetted holidays and National holidays and shall maintain attendance register which shall be kept at the office of J.E. (E) concerned.

12. The contractor shall submit the log sheet as per the performa enclosed regarding the status of street lighting points and other allied installations of the proceeding day, daily to the Engineer in charge in the division office, duly signed by him or his authorized representative whose particulars shall be furnished by the successful tenderer within 7 days after award of work.
13. If any staff deployed by the contractor is found absent on a particular time and date, an amount equal to minimum wages fixed by Delhi Administration from time to time shall be recovered from the contractor's bill.
14. In case of any disobedience or misbehavior by the operational staff of the contractor, the Engineer – in – Charge may ask the contractor to dispense with the services of such staff with immediate effect. The contractor shall provide suitable substitute simultaneously.
15. The contractor shall take all safety measures at site during maintenance of the installation.
16. Any injury/mishap to the maintenance staff during duty hours will solely be the liability of the contractor.
17. The contractor shall maintain the street lighting luminaries with wheel ladder / motorized ladder only.
18. Co-ordination and follow up action with Electric Supply Agency shall be done by the contractor in case of failure/fault in supply.
19. The contractor shall intimate the Engineer-in-Charge about the major breakdown or failure of electric supply immediately.
20. The following minor maintenance i/c preventive maintenance shall be carried out by the contractor. The details of work carried out shall be recorded in the register.
 - a) Supplying and replacement of kit kats and MCB's as and when required.
 - b) Supplying and replacement of thimbles and ferrules as and when required.
 - c) Supplying and replacement of copper wire of size 2.5mm as and when required.
 - d) Supplying and replacement of HRC fuses as and when required.
21. All electric connections shall be checked at least once in a month and set right, if required.
22. The contractor has to return the dismetalled material to the department after replacing the defective items at site for which separate payments are being made by the department.
