The following documents are required for conversion from leasehold to freehold in r/o built up shops as per brochure as well as in practice:-

- Undertaking duly attested by Notary Public/Magistrate 1st class on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 10/- on account of any amount is demanded viz. arrears of ground rent and/or interest thereon and any other dues found payable.
- Affidavit duly attested by Notary Public/Magistrate 1st class on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 10/- on account of all the documents submitted in support of conversion application are genuine & obtained from lawful custodian and DDA shall have all the rights to cancel the conveyance deed and to take action as per law.
- 3. Indemnity Bond duly attested by Notary Public/Magistrate 1st class on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- in consideration of the lessor agreeing to convert the leasehold rights in r/o of the property into freehold rights, the executant hereby convenants with the lessor that he/she will at all times indemnity and keep harmless the said lessor from all claims and demands made and all actions and proceedings taken against the said lessor.
- Copy of POA(S) alongwith Sale Agreement (Where application is made by attorney), duly attested by Notary Public/Gazetted Officer.
- - (ii) Proof of identification of the person in whose name the conversion is sought viz. ration card/passport/driving licence/postal identity card/voter or any other Govt. identity card with photo etc. duly attested by Notary Public/Gazetted Officer.
- 6. 4 attested passport size photographs and 4 attested specimen signature of the person in whose favour the conversion is sought.
- Details of payment of ground rent in Annexure 'H'.
- 8. Copy of lease deed/sub-lease deed/conveyance deed/allotment letter duly attested by Notary Public/Gazetted Officer.
- 9. Copy of N.O.C. from the mortgagee duly attested by Notary Public/Gazetted Officer.
- 10. Attested copy of partnership deed/memorandum and Articles of Association.
