MPD-2041: ONLINE PUBLIC CONSULTATION WITH YOUTH IN DELHI

Youth Sabha II: Creating safe and equitable access to public spaces

Delhi Development Authority (DDA) in association with The National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA), is preparing the next Master Plan of Delhi- 2041 (MPD-2041). As part of the process, a series of discussions and consultations have been carried out with various stakeholders and civil society groups to seek inputs from the people of Delhi that will help drive the agenda for the Master Plan. One of the important stakeholders are the youth, who form a significant portion of Delhi's population. To get insights from the youth of Delhi, a series of Youth Sabhas are being organized. The objective of these meetings is to understand issues faced by the youth (aged between 15-30 years) in the city and discuss possible planning solutions.

After the success of the first Youth Sabha on 24th September 2020, the second of the series is planned on the thematic of "Creating safe and equitable access to public spaces", on 01 October 2020, 3:00 pm onwards for which inviting registrations have been received from the youth of Delhi. This interactive discussion aims to understand the changing needs of recreational facilities, the challenges in terms of accessibility and adequacy of such infrastructure from young citizen of different socio economic constructs, including the larger public realm and what can be done to make the area safe for all through planning tools. As a design module to get feedback from each and every participant, all the three Sabhas will be anchored by youth representatives from DDA, NIUA and PRIA and IGSSS that are CSOs working with youth. Out of total 900 registrations, over 600 registrations have been received for this youth sabha.
